Phase 2: the teachers will help the kids with brainstorming about peace. What does peace mean to you? What does peace look like?

Phase 3: the kids will **interpret** the peace statements through their art.

Phase 4: the best 100 paintings will be chosen to be part of a big show next September in the City Hall - Kids art will sell for \$ 100 and the money raised will go back to help the ARTS in the Bermuda Schools.
